King's Head Inn – An authentic 19th century inn nestled in the heart of the village offers a unique venue for meetings or memorable spousal/evening functions. Coffee breaks, nutritious lunches and hearty Loyalist inspired dinners with costumed wait staff offer an “out-of-the-box” experience. Break out rooms are accessible and effective, with antiques or reproduction furniture. It also boasts an old-English-style pub and a garden for outdoor dining or refreshment (licensed).
